

Minutes of the meeting of Consultancy Evaluation Committee for Impact Evaluation of Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS) – Paramparagat Krishi Vikas Yojana (PKVY) under INM Division on 12.09.2019 under the Chairpersonship of Neeraja Adidam, Joint Secretary (INM), DAC&FW.

This division floated an online open tender No. 9-33/2019-Org.Fmg. dated 21.08.2019 (ID 2019_DACO_490202_1) on portal for selection of an agency for Impact evaluation of Centrally Sponsored Scheme. The last date for submission of bid was 20.08.2019 and technical Bids were opened on 21.08.2019.

2. For evaluation of the bids i.e. Technical & Financial bids, a Consultancy Evaluation Committee (CEC) was constituted comprising of Joint Secretary (INM), US (Finance), Deputy Commissioner (MIDH) and Deputy Secretary (Admin) vide order dated 07.08.2019.

3. Technical Bids were opened on 21.08.2019. Bids were received from the following eight bidders:

1. AFC India Limited
2. Arthot Group of Companies
3. Datamation Group
4. Indian Society of Agribusiness Professionals (ISAP)
5. MPCON Limited
6. NABARD Consultancy Services Pvt. Ltd.
7. Shivam Enterprises
8. WAPCOS Limited

4. All the bidders who have sent the soft and hard copy of the technical proposal were called for the presentation during CEC Meeting on 12th September, 2019. At 11:00 AM in Krishi Bhawan except Arthot Group of Companies as no hard copy of their technical proposal was received. As per RFP, it is mandatory for the agencies to submit proposal online as well as hard copies within the stipulated time failing which the proposals are liable to be rejected. Sh. Sushil Kumar Jha, US (Finance) & member of CEC has shown inability to attend the meeting.

5. The following vendors were not found eligible during the CEC Meeting for evaluation of technical proposal on account of the reasons mentioned below:

- (i) Shivam Enterprises: a) Annual Turnover is less than Rs 10 crore except last financial year; b) They have provided total 3 assignments, out of which

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assignments 2 & 3 are not eligible as duration of conduct of assignments is not within the stipulated time period.


- (ii) NABARD Consultancy Services Pvt. Ltd.: a) They have submitted total 3 assignments out of which one assignment is not eligible as duration is not within the stipulated time period; b) Not having requisite qualification of the key personnel i.e. doctorate or post doctorate experience.

6. The following consultancy firms are qualified for evaluation of their technical proposal:

- a) AFC India Limited,
- b) Indian Society of Agribusiness Professionals (ISAP),
- c) Datamation Group,
- d) MPCON Limited and
- e) WAPCOS Limited

7. On the basis of evaluation of the technical proposals of the eligible firms, the recommendation of the CEC is as follows:
