

Revised minutes of the meeting of Consultancy Evaluation Committee for Impact Evaluation of Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS) - Mission Organic Value Chain Development for North Eastern Regions (MOVCDNER) under INM Division on 12.09.2019 under the Chairpersonship of Neeraja Adidam, Joint Secretary (INM), DAC&FW.

This division floated an online open tender No. 9-22/2019-Org.Fmg dated 21.08.2019 (Tender ID No. 2019_DACO_490216_1) on portal for selection of an agency for Impact evaluation of Centrally Sponsored Scheme MOVCDNER. The last date for submission of bid was 20.08.2019 and technical bids were opened on 21.08.2019.

2. For evaluation of the bids i.e. Technical & Financial bids, a Consultancy Evaluation Committee (CEC) was constituted comprising of Joint Secretary (INM), US (Finance), Deputy Commissioner (MIDH) and Deputy Secretary (Admin) vide order dated 07.08.2019.

3. Technical Bids were opened on 21.08.2019. It was mandatory for the bidders to submit proposal online as well as hard copies within the stipulated time failing which the proposals are liable to be rejected. Online as well as hard copies of the bids were received from the following bidders:

1. AFC India Limited
2. Indian Society of Agribusiness Professionals (ISAP)
3. MPCON Limited
4. NABARD Consultancy Services Pvt. Ltd.
5. Shivam Enterprises
6. Sigma Research and consulting Pvt. Ltd.
7. WAPCOS LIMITED

Since, International Competence Centre for Organic Agriculture, (ICCOA) did not submit online proposal, this bid could not be considered for evaluation.

4. The other bidders namely: AFC India Limited, Indian Society of Agribusiness Professionals (ISAP), MPCON Limited, WAPCOS LIMITED, NABARD Consultancy Services Pvt. Ltd, Shivam Enterprises and Sigma Research and consulting Pvt. Ltd were invited for presentation on 12th September, 2019 and evaluation of the Technical bids was done. Sh. Sushil Kumar Jha, US (Fin-VI) has shown inability to attend the CEC meeting.

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5. The following bidders were not found eligible during the CEC meeting for evaluation of technical proposals on account of the reasons mentioned below:

i. Shivam Enterprises

Reason: It does not fulfil the minimum criteria of at least Rs. 10 crore turnover in last three financial year, hence not considered.

ii. Sigma Research and consulting Pvt. Ltd.

Reason: It does not fulfil the minimum criteria of at least Rs. 10 crore turnover in last three financial year, hence not considered.

6. On the basis of evaluation of the Technical bids of the eligible firms, the recommendation of the CEC is as follows:
